AMENDED
WRIT OF REPLEVIN

WHEREAS this cause came on for hearing on the 6th day of October 2020 on Plaintiff's *Motion for Replevin* with bond. Petitioner appears via *Zoom* and Defendants appeared through counsel Robert Rennie.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Plaintiff is entitled to possession of her (1) 1 black-backed jackal (referred to by the Defendant as a "golden jackal"), (1) African Crested Porcupine (referred to as an "African Brush-Tailed Porcupine" by the Defendant),¹ (1) Red Fox, (1) Arctic Fox; (2) Fisher cats and (2) Virginia Opossums, last known to be located at the Lowes' new zoological facility at 21619 Jimbo Road, Thackerville, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that Defendant shall surrender said animals on November 22, 2020 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM CST (9:00 AM - 1:00 PM EST) when the carrier will pick the animals up from the Defendants' new zoological facility, "Tiger King Park",² located at 21619 Jimbo Road, Thackerville, Oklahoma 73459 behind the Windstar Casino.

¹ The jackal is referred to as a "golden jackal" and the African Crested Porcupine is referred to as an "African Brush-Tailed Porcupine" in the USDA Inspection Reports of 2018 and 2019 for Jeff Lowe. The last page(s) of the report is the live inventory or regulated species list of the facility.

² Before Jeff Lowe forfeited his USDA License, the new zoo in Thackerville was referred to as "Red River Safari". This was during his partnership with Tim Stark of *Wildlife in Need* in Indiana. However, since the end of the partnership and Mr. Lowe's USDA licensure, the new zoo has gone by different names such as "The Oklahoma Zoo" and "Tiger King Park".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Sheriff of Love County, Oklahoma may immediately seize said described property, if necessary, and deliver it to Plaintiff on or after November 22, 2020, upon certified copy of this order being furnished to said officer.
